Security for the Small Museum: Practical Low and No Cost Solutions.

A half day workshop designed for small museums with 10 or fewer staff (paid or unpaid) who are looking to improve or learn about museum security. It will present practical tips that anyone can implement with little or no cost and will focus on non-technical solutions.

COST: \$20.00 per person

Host Museum requirements:

Space to hold the workshop with seating and tables for 10 to 20 participants (or more)

10 participant minimum

Provide assistance to Collections Research for Museums to recruit participants from small museums in your area by providing a list of those museums and contact information and/or sending invitations directly

PowerPoint projector and screen desirable (let Collections Research for Museums know if you do not have access to this technology and we can provide it)

Coffee, Hot Water, and Snacks for the participants (if your space allows food and drink; discuss with Collections Research for Museum)

Workshop can be morning (8am to 12pm) or afternoon (1pm to 5pm) or if you wish to provide lunch for the participants we can schedule for mid-morning to mid-afternoon

Outside Colorado/Wyoming Area travel costs for trainer may apply.
